The use of high-quality raw materials, such as the special alloy containing cobalt and stainless steel, represents a guarantee for the product itself and its long life.

Each pair of scissors is handmade, passing through more than 70 steps, exclusively for Iv San Bernard and embodies the spirit of the ancient samurai: harmony, strength and elegance, three qualities that associate the blades of these beautiful scissors to the fearsome katana of the powerful Japanese warriors.

Iv San Bernard's Hakira scissors embody the centuries-old experience of traditional craftsmanship and the most advanced Japanese technology to offer exceptional cutting performances. The blades open and close with such a gentle movement that the feeling is similar to holding a feather; in addition they have rounded tips to ensure greater safety.

Each scissor is equipped with a tension screw so that the resistance of the blades can be perfectly adjusted directly with the fingers. Correct maintenance is, as always, essential to keep the line sharp; nevertheless, the Hakira are of such a high quality that even after years of use, they will continue to be as perfect as when used for the first time.

Each pair of scissors is handmade and embodies the skill of the artisans who produce them and who care not only of the tradition but also of each single product's quality: Iv San Bernard aspires to distribute scissors of the highest quality and professionalism.

The peculiarity of Hakira scissors lies in their lightness and manageability, so as to make them perfect for both less experienced groomers and great professionals: the result on the coat will always be magnificent.

Thinning scissors are mainly recommended to adjust the volume of the mantle and thanks to the millimeter precision mechanism all scissors are equipped with, you can choose how to work the mantle in a precise and accurate way. In addition, the ergonomic handle gives each pair a comfortable grip that makes it very manageable and with an exact cut.

permette infine di irrobustire le forbici



The **Hakira** Scissors are made of Japanese 440C
steel (Rockwell 59) for the left-handed version and
steel VG10 (Rockwell 61) for the right version. They
pass through more than **70 steps of processing** to
obtain a perfect and linear finish.

An additional carbon finish finally allows
to strengthen the scissors
and make them more durable.



Acciaio VG10

Le forbici Hakira nella versione per destri sono realizzate in Acciaio VG10, chiamato anche "Acciaio d'Oro".

Un acciaio inossidabile che contiene l'1% di Carbonio che lo rende più duro di molti altri tipi di acciaio INOX (Rockwell 61).

Le caratteristiche di taglio sono davvero eccellenti: l'Acciaio VG10 è facile da affilare e resiste molto bene alle ossidazioni.

VG10 Steel

Hakira scissors are made of VG10(Rockwell 61) steel, also called "Golden Steel", for the right-handed version.

A stainless steel that contains 1% carbon which makes it harder than many other types of stainless steel (Rockwell 61).

The cutting characteristics are truly excellent: VG10 steel is easy to sharpen and resists oxidation very well.



Recommendations for use

- HAKIRA scissors are precision tools and should be treated and cared for as such.
 - The scissors blades should be cleaned after each use with a damp and soft cloth or with a chamois leather cloth.
 - The pin should be oiled regularly.
 - The scissor tension should be regularly checked and adjusted, if necessary, using the screw in the box.
 - To prevent damage to the scissors, we recommend storing them always indoor, safe and dry.
- The scissors should be resharpened or repaired directly by the Iv San Bernard company.
